Why is the CS Program Relevant to **Everyone**?

Conflict resolution can begin with Anonymous Communication

- Easy, Safe, Convenient, Fast, ANONYMOUS way to communicate with the Police about felony level criminal activity.
- PD obtains vital info that helps them make an arrest Tipster always remains anonymous, and therefore, will never have to testify.
 - (State of Mo., Anonymity Clause, Chapter 546, RSMo)
- Cash rewards for TIPS that lead to a felony arrest.
 (Schools provide own reward system unless it's a felony.)
- In schools, Info provided is not just about crime, but can also be about bullying or a person's mental well being.

There is a saying in police work that "Somebody always knows." Many of these people, however, are reluctant to talk to police for two main reasons...

·Fear of Reprisal ·Apathy – "Why should I get involved?"
